

Subject: Idea on alternative feeds for aquaculture.

Insects, such as caterpillars and grasshoppers, fed a diet of mostly native plants and tree leaves. This type of feed source encourages native plantings and landscapes such as tallgrass prairies, forests, and savannas. Leaves and grass could be sustainably harvested from these landscapes to feed the stock of insects. These insects would then serve as feed for aquaculture.
